Music Submission Guidelines

Submit two music and/or video selections as MP3s, YouTube.com, SoundCloud, or Bandcamp links of projects you have recorded and/or mixed either in a recording or live performance setting.

If submitting videos, the videos may be of you or someone else singing two of your original compositions. If someone else is performing on the videos you must make an on-camera introduction of each song and performer(s). **All songs must be written solely by you.** You can either upload your video to YouTube.com and submit your link(s) (see below). You are encouraged to submit lyric sheets with your songs. You must provide a brief yet detailed description of what you did and how you did it for each selection (i.e. recorded, mixed, equipment used, location, etc.). Please label your materials with your name, phone number and Career Track.

Scholarship Request Guidelines

There are limited funds available for scholarships to cover camp admission and fees. To be considered for a scholarship, you must submit the following information, in addition to all other camp forms. You will NOT be eligible to receive a scholarship if your camp packet is incomplete. The entire packet is due by April 14th.

To apply for a scholarship, please submit:

- A letter of recommendation from a teacher/principal/mentor
- A parent's most recent IRS 1040 tax form
- Examples of your original work (see "Music Submission Guidelines" above)
- An essay on why you wish to attend this camp (see details below)

Essay Guidelines: Write and submit a 1-page paper with this camp packet. In this essay, please discuss what you want to gain from this camp, and how will apply what you learn to your future musical endeavors. Complete this essay on a separate piece of paper and include in your application packet.
